Description of the global subproject.

Inside the European regions, most of the historical centres of cities are protected being considered as cultural interest elements. This protection seeks the conservation of the whole historical architectural styles as well as their space or urban environments, but avoiding to become them into museums, the social surroundings transformation and the unbalance of their urban functions.

With these aim, component 2 of "Assistance program and supporting Urban Management (PAGUS)" is created. Regional Environment Activity inside the South Area of INTERREG III-C OF THE European Commission: "Managing of human resources in the historical centres rehabilitation".

In Santiago, Cádiz, Granada e Guimaraes there was "Workshop for Urban Renovation and Restoration". Talks, seminars, practical sessions and tutorials have been held. The destinataries were the professional technicians.

Knowledge of the disappear heritage in European cities***

The consolidation of the concept that for the effective conservations of the historical centres are needly the participation of the following agents:

- Qualified technicians and companies with specialized knowledge according to the own characteristics of every architectural style which is tried to rehabilitate.
- Public managers able to attend the residents, individualising every case by advising and channelling every assistance demand in the housing renovation.
- Institutions which create useful knowledge. Therefore, the agents which work in the conservation and recovery of historical urban centres can base on solid appropriate criteria depending on the particular conditions of every region and, at the same time, can join the different factors which take part in this field.

Foreseen effects at short and a long term. Ex: European awareness of the disappear heritage

In order to keep inhabited those historical centres, mostly occupied by marginal or poor population sectors, avoiding at the same time the overpopulation or an abusive tourist use, territorial programs of support to the recovery of the habitability of housing and buildings are needed to settle the resident population and interventional programs dedicated to get better surroundings and the creation and endowing of equipments and services which make coexistence and life easier. The citys and mostly the residents and users of Historic Centers, benefited with this action of project PAGUS, because this action had allowed to reformulate the actual paradigm of the sustainable urban development in Historic Centers.

Partiendo de la experiencia del Aula de Rehabilitación del Consorcio, esta oficina municipal y el Instituto Galego de Vivenda e Solo (IGVS) quieren organizar cursos para la capacitación de personal en materia de rehabilitación. Pretenden promoverlos dentro de programas europeos.

Y precisamente, una iniciativa comunitaria, el programa de asistencia y gestión urbana sostenible (**Pagus**), reunirá hoy y mañana en Santiago a su comité de dirección para evaluar, seleccionar y aprobar los proyectos presentados a dicho programa, al que optan varios municipios gallegos.

Pagus es una iniciativa que se incluye en el Interreg IIIC que tiene por fin favorecer el desarrollo y conservación sostenible de los centros históricos europeos en ciudades y villas de pequeño y mediano tamaño. El programa cuenta con un presupuesto de 7 millones y la UE financiará el 75% de los seleccionados.
